NOTICE OF RACE

1 RULES

- 1.1 The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing*.

2 ADVERTISING

Advertising will be restricted to Category C.

3 ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- 3.1 The regatta is open to all boats of the 2.4 mR class. All participants shall be current members of their National Class Association or a member of the International Class Association.
- 3.2 Eligible boats may enter by completing the attached form and sending it, together with the required fee, to Mariehamns Seglarförening rf by e-mail 2.4NM2010@gmail.com or by fax +358 18 31521. For bank information, please, see end of this NOR.
- 3.3 Entries are due by July 9, 2010. Late entries will be accepted until July 30, 2010, with an additional fee of 20€.

5 FEES

- 5.1 Entering fee is 100€, late entry 120€. Fee including launching, hauling, dock space and trailer parking.

7 SCHEDULE

- 7.1 Registration: August 05, 2010 from 1800 to 2100. August 06, 2010 from 1200 to 2000.
- 7.2 Measurement and inspection: August 06, 2010 1200 to 2000.
- 7.3 Tune up race August 06, 2010, scheduled time of warning signal 1825.
Dates of racing: August 07 – August 08, 2010.
- 7.4 Six races are sheduled, three each day. One extra race may be sailed on August 07.

- 7.5 The scheduled time of the warning signal for the first race each day each day is 10.55.
- 8 MEASUREMENTS**
Each boat shall produce a valid measurement certificate.
- 9 SAILING INSTRUCTIONS**
Preliminary sailing instructions will be available by May 1, 2010, on www.msf.ax.
Final sailing instructions will be available at registration.
- 10 VENUE**
10.1 Attachment A shows the location of the regatta harbour and racing area.
- 11 THE COURSES**
The courses to be a windward – leeward configuration. Race duration is planned to be 60 minutes.
- 12 PENALTY SYSTEM**
12.1 The Scoring Penalty, rule 44.3, will not apply.
- 13 SCORING**
13.2 Three races are required to be completed to constitute a series.
13.3 (a) When fewer than 6 races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores.
(b) When 6 races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores excluding her worst score.
- 14 SUPPORT BOATS**
Support boats shall keep clear from the race area when boats are racing, except when ordered by the race committ  to assist boats in danger.
- 15 BERTHING**
Boats shall be kept in their assigned places in the harbour.
- 16 HAUL-OUT RESTRICTIONS**
Keel boats shall not be hauled out during the regatta except with and according to the terms of prior written permission of the race committee.
- 17 DIVING EQUIPMENT AND PLASTIC POOLS**
Underwater breathing apparatus and plastic pools or their equivalent shall not be used around keel boats between the preparatory signal of the first race and the end of the regatta.

18 RADIO COMMUNICATION

A boat shall neither make radio transmissions while racing nor receive radio communications not available to all boats. This restriction also applies to mobile telephones.
